- The issues discussed must be of high concerned with respect to the students and institution as well.
- The committee could take contingence of any matter it finds important for the welfare of the students.
- Director/ Principal/ Hostel Wardens could refer the matter to Personal Grievances Cell if find unable to resolve the issue.
- Any student could come to the Cell for any problem if not satisfy with the student welfare forum.
- The words from the committee would be final in case of any controversy or problem.

3. **Anti Ragging Squad** :

The institution strictly discourages any kind of ragging activity inside or outside the college premises. Ragging is totally banned in any form in ACPR and those found to be indulged in ragging would face dire consequences. Strict disciplinary action as well as legal action against those indulged in ragging will be must which would leads to immediate rustication and in turns could lead to omission of the student and filing the case in police station for legal action .
